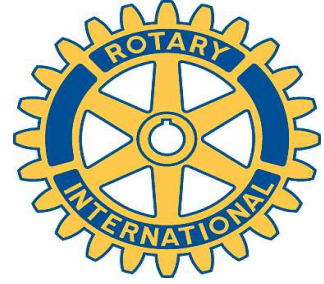

### ROTARY VENDORS

There are about 150 licensed vendors of RI merchandise in 31 countries. Any company or individual wishing to manufacture or sell items containing the Rotary name, the Rotary emblem, or any of the other Rotary designs or logos must be authorized by RI. By licensing vendors or makers of Rotary related goods, RI maintains control over its name and insignia. Years ago, when the Wankel Rotary automobile engine was introduced, an

advertisement urged: “Join the Rotary club.”

The ad was stopped by legal action.

Attendance at Rotary conventions has varied greatly over 100 years. The two smallest conventions were in Chicago in 1910 (the first, with 60 delegates) and 1945, near the end of World War II (with 141 participants). The largest RI conventions were in 1978 in Tokyo, Japan (39,834 participants), and Seoul, Korea, in 1989 (38,878 attendees). The 2005 convention in Chicago held promise of setting a new record during Rotary’s centennial year.
