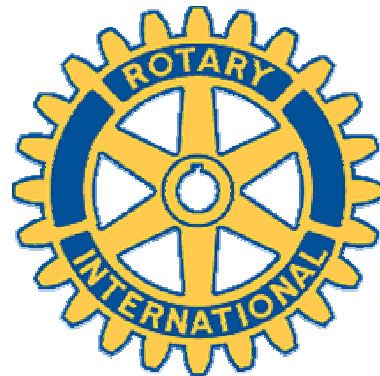

New Club Year Checklist

It's a new year, and with it comes new responsibilities for you as a Rotarian. Here are some items to think about.

1. As of today, the entire club has 100% attendance. Make a commitment to make every meeting you possibly can, and to make up any meetings you must miss. Make-up opportunities are conveniently listed on every issue of the newsletter, and there are generally two meetings, the Rotary board and the Rotary housing board, scheduled for each month. Committee meetings usually also count for a make-up, so there's really no reason not to have 100% attendance!
2. Identify a new member, and invite them to a meeting. Share your enthusiasm with someone new! Ask any board member about new member sponsorship procedures.
3. Are you supporting your Rotary Foundation? It is a goal of our club to have 100% of our membership donating to the Rotary Foundation. It's easy to do. Just tell Fred Bowers how much you want billed to your monthly account. A minimum donation of \$10 is suggested. This small amount multiplies itself in many ways, and should be fairly painless, particularly for those of you whose dues are company-paid. A future newsletter will detail more about how these monies benefit the world.
4. Choose your areas of service. This is what Rotary membership is all about, and should be your primary focus. Our club is divided into lanes of service, and a club director heads up each lane. Under each lane are multiple committees, where all the actual work gets done. Don't wait to be
