He has been doing archaeological research in Val Verde County for many years, and has been part of the earliest "digs" in the area. He gave us a fact-filled and interesting talk about the Bonfire Shelter, the oldest known jump site in North America.

A Rotary Moment



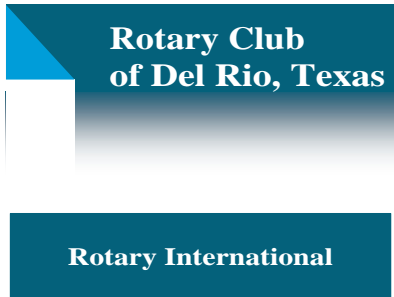
Consider the following list of prominent persons:
