Who in my club can serve as my mentor?

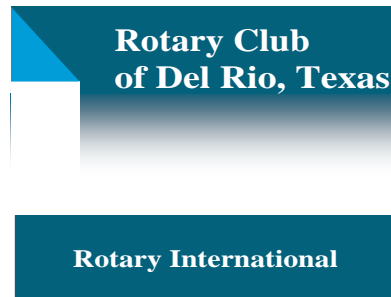
What opportunities are there for getting involved in international service?
