"Encroachment" Beau Nettleton explained problems as well as possible solutions to the future of Laughlin AFB. He stated the best possible solution is the creation of a "MUNICIPAL AND COUNTY ZONING AUTHORITY AROUND AIR FORCE FACILITY".

He came prepared with documentation for presentation to the Texas legislature as well as a brochure by Laughlin entitled DEL RIO JOINT

LAND USE STUDY. From this study, it was determined that ideally Laughlin would prefer a MFI Military Influence Area of 5 miles from the center of the runways. It was explained that this would not only protect the base when there is another round of base closings, but would also increase the possibility of having room for other missions that could be frozen out of their present locations.
